VALLEE HELPS AID MEDWAY SENIOR CENTER

(BOSTON) - Representative James E. Vallee (D-Franklin) announced that his efforts in the recently completed budget deliberations for Fiscal Year 2009 have paid dividends for the Medway Senior Center. Due in large part to Representative Vallee's advocacy, the Medway Senior Center, located on Oakland Street, will receive \$100,000.00 to complete the new addition. "This financial assistance will provide the money for the Senior Center to complete its addition and renovation project. Given the increasing numbers of seniors and the limited fiscal capabilities of municipalities, this money is essential to provide a positive, fulfilling atmosphere at the Medway Senior Center," said Representative Vallee.

The Medway Senior Center serves many local residents and with the addition and renovations, which include a large exercise room, a computer lab and library the center will, be able to provide extended services and programs .
