REP. VALLEE ANNOUNCES RECENT RMV POLICY

(Boston) – Rep. James E. Vallee (D- Franklin) announces that the Massachusetts Registry of Motor Vehicles has recently instituted a new policy regarding licensed drivers of the Commonwealth. The Registrar has issued an alert that they will no longer mail out license renewal and vehicle inspection notices.

Representative Vallee realizes that this is an important issue and wants to make sure that the message is received by his constituents. Vallee urges licensed drivers to pay close attention to when their licenses are due for renewal and to make the necessary changes. He wants to make sure drivers are well aware so that they are not unintentionally driving with an expired license, which could conceivably result in a fine if pulled over.
