**REP. VALLEE ANNOUNCES FINAL  
PROJECT PAYMENTS TO MEDWAY**

Rep James E. Vallee (D-Franklin) and Katherine P. Craven, Executive Director of the Massachusetts School Building Authority announced today that the town of Medway will receive nearly \$2 million in reimbursements for school renovation projects.

The McGovern Elementary School received 64.06% reimbursement for the roof replacement project. The projects final cost was over \$920,000 and the town will receive \$589,908 from the School Building Authority.

The Middle School roof with a replacement cost of \$1.4 million will receive 64.06% reimbursement from the School Building Authority amounting to over \$922,000.

The Burke Elementary School replaced its boiler and roof at a cost of \$717,823 of which the state will reimburse 62.16% to the town. The states share amounts to \$454,278 for these projects.

Representative Vallee was pleased that he played a role in the authorization of these reimbursements to the town. "I am always pleased when I am able to provide assistance to the residents of the 10<sup>th</sup> Norfolk District. Medway has made great strides in the past two years in recovering its financial footing and it is very satisfying when the state is able to reimburse over 60% of the costs of these projects." Vallee continued, "It is my hope that the accelerated reimbursement from the School Building Authority will help reduce the debt burden and tax rate for the citizens of Medway."
